## MONMOUTHSHIRE AND BRECON CANAL - CRUMLIN ARM WORKING GROUP (20TH SEPTEMBER 2005)

## **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

- To oversee the ongoing management and maintenance of the Crumlin Arm of the Monmouthshire and Brecon Canal as it currently exists and to put in place measures to licence and control activities on the canal and in its environs.
- To take forward any proposals, measures and conclusions, set out within the Corridor Study, which are, in the future, adopted as policy by the Council with the aim of facilitating the development of the canal and the restoration of the canal to navigable standards.
- To support, and participate in, the Council's involvement with all external partners having the aim of restoring the Monmouthshire and Brecon Canal network by the year 2020 in accordance with council policy
- To take account of the response received from the public to the proposals and recommendations set out in the Canal Corridor Study.
- To ensure that the conclusions and recommendations of the Corridor Study are taken into account during the preparation and development of the Local Development Plan.
- To take account of the actions of Newport City Council in the restoration of that length of the Crumlin Arm that lies outside the Caerphilly County Borough area.
