*Note for attending in a vehicle with a view to removing goods (AVR) – Council Tax Only

Scenario 1

- If the bailiffs hold more than 1 liability order for a debtor & progress to an AVR visit (first time) the bailiff may charge £125.00.
- Subsequent visits will attract a £50.00 AVR fee, provided the bailiffs hold an additional levied liability order to which an AVR fee has not previously been applied.

Scenario 2

- If any more liability orders are received at a later date for the same debtor, they would be dealt with as a separate action i.e. £125.00 for the first AVR visit.
- Subsequent visits will attract £50.00 AVR fee, provided the bailiffs hold an additional levied liability order to which an AVR fee has not previously been applied.

In both scenarios bailiffs <u>cannot</u> charge an AVR fee once all available levied liability orders have had an AVR fee applied.

AVR Fees – Council Tax

The Local Authority's written consent (fax) must be obtained **before** the bailiff charges an AVR fee on attending to remove goods. An AVR fee is **not** to be charged on a first or subsequent visit unless the debtor refuses to sign a Walking Possession agreement.
