A meeting of the **Rights of Way Cabinet Committee** will be held in the Sirhowy Room, Penallta House, Tredomen Business Park, Ystrad Mynach, CF82 7PG on **Monday, 3rd December, 2018** at 1.30pm to consider the matters contained in the following agenda. You are welcome to use Welsh at the meeting, we require a minimum notice period of 3 working days and a simultaneous translation will be provided if requested.

All Committee meetings are open to the Press and Public, observers and participants are asked to conduct themselves with respect and consideration for others. Please note that failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the meeting and you may be escorted from the premises.

Prior to the meeting, a site inspection will be convened at 10.30am leading from Park Lane along the access track leading to the allotments, then turns in a Southerly direction alongside the Children's play area, across the recreation ground and over the stream and into Coed-y-Twyn woods. The footpath continues in a South Easterly direction through the woods until it reaches a stream where it crosses into a field for a few meters and joins Footpath 39 Caerphilly. Members of the Committee have delegated powers to determine the applications and are under a duty to act in a quasi-judicial capacity. In order to discharge that duty, Members of the Committee must attend the site inspections and the meeting. **(Please note appropriate footwear will be required).**
