SUBJECT: DOG CONTROL ORDERS

REPORT BY: DEPUTY CHIEF EXECUTIVE

- 1.1 The attached report that details the outcome of a public consultation exercise and sought Members' views on proposals to introduce a Dog Control Order to exclude dogs from enclosed children's play areas and Multi Use Games Areas, was considered by the Regeneration and Environment Scrutiny Committee on 11th December 2012.
- 1.2 Following discussion on the content of the report, the Scrutiny Committee endorsed the proposed Dog Control Orders and recommended their approval to Cabinet, in relation to the following:
 - (a) The exclusion of dogs from enclosed children's play areas and Multi Use Games Areas (MUGAs);
 - (b) Failing to remove dog faeces from enclosed children's play areas and Multi Use Games Areas (MUGAs).
- 1.3 Members are asked to consider the recommendations and confirm the making of the proposed Orders with a commencement date of 1st May 2013.
