SUBJECT: GELLIGAER CEMETERY EXTENSION

REPORT BY: ACTING CHIEF EXECUTIVE

- 1.1 The attached report was considered by the Regeneration and Environment Scrutiny Committee on 21st May 2013.
- 1.2 The report sought approval for a joint working project between Caerphilly CBC and Cardiff University Archaeological Department at Gelligaer Cemetery extension site.
- 1.3 Following detailed consideration of the report, the Scrutiny Committee unanimously endorsed the recommendations contained therein, as follows: -
