SUBJECT: REVIEW OF THE OPERATION AND PARKING CHARGES FOR BLUE BADGE HOLDERS IN COUNCIL PUBLIC CAR PARKS

REPORT BY: ACTING DIRECTOR OF CORPORATE SERVICES AND SECTION 151 OFFICER

- 1.1 The attached report, which provided details of the outcome of a review carried out on the operation and current parking charges for blue badge holders in the Council's off-street public car parks and sought the views of Members on the proposed recommendations contained therein, was considered by the Regeneration and Environment Scrutiny Committee on 10th December 2013.
- 1.2 Following discussion on the content of the report, the Regeneration and Environment Scrutiny Committee recommended to Cabinet that for the reasons contained therein:-
- (i) additional disabled parking bays be provided in 12 pay and display car parks;
 - (ii) a number of existing disabled parking bays be increased in size in 9 pay and display car parks;
 - (iii) concession of 1 hour extra free parking for blue badge holders be introduced in all pay and display car parks;
 - (iv) on-street parking exemptions for blue badge holders be better publicised/promoted.
- 1.3 Members are asked to consider the recommendations.
