SUBJECT: ADULT SERVICES MINI BUS FLEET

REPORT BY: ACTING DIRECTOR OF CORPORATE SERVICES AND SECTION 151 OFFICER

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- 1.1 The attached report, which provides information on the fleet of specially adapted minibuses providing transport for adult social care service users and updates Members on the proposals to replace 4 of the vehicles, was presented to the Health, Social Care and Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee on 25th March 2014.
 - 1.2 During the course of the discussion at the Scrutiny Committee meeting a request was made for a report to be prepared on the usage of these vehicles across the Directorate. Officers advised that this matter was already being addressed and that a report would be brought back to the Scrutiny Committee in due course.
 - 1.3 It was moved and seconded that the recommendation to note the content of the report be approved. By a show of hands this was unanimously endorsed. .
 - 1.4 Cabinet Members are asked to: -
 1. Note the purchase of a second hand vehicle from 2013/14 Social Services revenue budget underspends.
 2. Endorse the proposal in paragraph 4.6 of the attached report to utilise £201k from Social Services reserves to purchase 3 new vehicles.
