- 1.1 The attached report was presented to the Regeneration and Environment Scrutiny Committee on 20th May 2014. The report provides information on the public consultation of the draft Caerphilly Town Centre Air Quality Action Plan, including an overview of feedback received during the process and seeks Cabinet approval to endorse the final version of the Caerphilly Town Centre Air Quality Action Plan prior to its submission to Welsh Government.
- 1.2 The draft Air Quality Action Plan for the Caerphilly Town Centre AQMA has recently been through a 3-month public consultation process, with only one response received. The draft Air Quality Action Plan needs to be formally submitted to Welsh Government and the actions detailed within it, once approved, will be implemented
- 1.3 Following discussion on the content of the report, the Regeneration and Environment Scrutiny Committee unanimously endorsed the final version of the Caerphilly Town Centre Air Quality Action Plan prior to it being referred to Cabinet for approval.
- 1.4 Members are asked to endorse the final version of the Caerphilly Town Centre Air Quality Action Plan prior to its submission to Welsh Government.
