SUBJECT: NON-RESIDENTS BURIAL FEES

- 1.1 The attached report was considered by the Regeneration and Environment Scrutiny Committee on 20th May 2014.
 - 1.2 The report sought Members' views on the proposal to cease the current policy of charging double fees for non-residents of the County Borough who wish to be interred in one of its ten municipal cemeteries. The proposal to cease the policy will protect the Authority from potential legal challenges
 - 1.3 Following consideration by members of the Scrutiny Committee, it was moved and seconded that the recommendation in the report be approved. By a show of hands this was unanimously endorsed.
 - 1.4 Members are therefore asked to consider the following recommendation: -

"To cease the policy of charging double fees for non-residents who wish to be interred in one of the ten municipal cemeteries, if they have not been resident in the County Borough for more than one year prior to death."
