4. NATIONAL HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY

Members received a presentation from Helen Bartley RE Teacher at Newbridge following a visit by a party of pupils to two Concentration Camps, Auschwitz and Birkenau in Germany and Poland in October 2005. She recounted some of the pupil's experiences and reactions to the places events and people they had meet with direct experiences of the Holocaust and circulated examples of the pupils work written as a result of the visits.

This was then followed by a presentation from Vicky Thomas entitled "One Person Can Make a Difference" on individuals whose actions, beliefs and ideals throughout history had made an impact on society and the world we live in.
