Parking:

There are 3 car parks close by.

One is the Emporium Car Park a little above Gigabites, the other is the locally named old Kwik Save (Now CK Car Park) both PAY AND DISPLAY. One is 50 yards up a hill the other 50 yards down a hill.

There is also the main larger car park which is FREE: For people travelling to Bargoed from the south (through Pengam) travel to Bargoed Bus Station (on your left) and turn right immediately before the Library (on your right in front of you) follow the road north into the car park (DO NOT TURN RIGHT AT THE LIBRARY) park as close to the end as possible. Walk up the lane by Chisholms Furniture Warehouse/ Barclays Bank and Gigabites is 40 yards down the road on the opposite side.
