- 2.1 AQA was formed on 1st April 2000 following mergers between the Associated Examining Board (AEB), The Joint Matriculation Board (JMB) and the Northern Examinations and Assessment Board (NEAB).
- 2.2 AQA is currently the largest of the three English exam boards that set and mark public exams such as GCSEs and A Levels, as well as other qualifications. In addition they are the main provider of qualifications for UK schools and colleges.
