2.1 It should be noted that definitive conclusions cannot be drawn because the figures represent raw scores and do not necessarily reflect the selectivity of the entry and in some cases the numbers are too small to be statistically significant.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1 Members of the SACRE are asked to note and discuss the examination results and to consider writing to schools regarding the 2007 examination performance commenting upon:
- A trend of very good performance at GCSE full course;
 - A satisfactory performance at GCSE Short Course;
 - A significant improvement in A level results at grades A and A-C and that there is a 100% pass rate;
 - AS results better than previous performance and All Wales figures.
