## Comments

- There were 584 entries this year from 13 schools. This is a significant increase over 2006 and there has been a year on year increase in entry numbers since 2004.
- The overall \% of $\mathbf{A}^{*}$ - $\mathbf{C}$ grades for Caerphilly was $72.9 \%$. This is a good result and although below last year's performance is better than the All-Wales figure of 70.4\%
- The overall \% of $\mathbf{A}^{*}$-G grades for Caerphilly was $99.3 \%$. This again is a very good result and comparable with 2006 and the All-Wales figure of $97.8 \%$.
- The overall \% of $\mathbf{A}^{*}$-A grades for Caerphilly was $28.3 \%$ and although below the All-Wales figure of $30.4 \%$ and the 2006 performance there has been a consistency in a significant \% of pupils achieving this top grade over a three-year period.


## Conclusion

- The results this year, once again are very good at all grades and generally comparable with previous performance and the All Wales figures. Schools are to be commended at maintaining such good examination results.

## Comments

- There were 1013 entries this year from 12 schools. Numbers have gone down but many schools now enter pupils for Further Short Course and this enables them to have a full GCSE qualification. Their results will then show in Full Course data.
- The overall \% of $\mathbf{A}^{*}$-C grades for Caerphilly was $54 \%$ and is comparable to previous performance but below the All Wales figure of $60.4 \%$
- The overall \% of $\mathbf{A}^{*}$-G grades for Caerphilly was $92.2 \%$ and is below previous performance and the All-Wales figure of 95.9\%
- The overall \% of $\mathbf{A}^{*}$ - $\mathbf{A}$ grades for Caerphilly was $17.1 \%$ and is better than previous performance but below the All-Wales figure of $20.6 \%$.


## Conclusions

- There have been steady entry numbers for short course over the last three years.
- The results at all grades are satisfactory although below All - Wales figures at all grade boundaries. However, we must bear in mind that this course is not an option but a fulfilment of statutory requirements and it is very pleasing to see $92.2 \%$ of pupils receiving some kind of accreditation for their studies at KS4.

## Comments

- A total of 67 candidates from 6 schools were entered for the exam. There were less entered this year.
- Those pupils achieving A grade were $23.9 \%$ and this was a significant improvement over 2006 and better than the All Wales figure of 19.5\%
- The \% pass rate for grades A-C was $83.6 \%$ and this was a significant improvement over 2006 and better than the All Wales figure of $75.9 \%$
- The \% pass rate for grades A - E was excellent at $100 \%$ and exceeds previous performance and the All-Wales figures of 98.5\%.


## Conclusions

- It is encouraging to see that results have significantly improved at grades A and A-C and that all pupils entered passed their exams.

## Comments

- There were a total of 72 candidates from 7 schools for the AS examination. This figure is similar to the numbers entered in 2006.
- At A-E the pass rate was $95.8 \%$ and this is better than 2006 and the All Wales figure of 91.1\%
- At A-C the pass rate was $65.3 \%$ and this is comparable with 2006 and better than the All Wales figure of 60.2\%\%
- At A grade there was a $19.4 \%$ pass rate and this exceeds the All Wales figure and previous performance.

At all grade boundaries results are better than previous performance and the All-Wales figures.

SACRE needs to take into account that there is still a very incomplete picture at AS because the grades are accumulated over a two year period.
