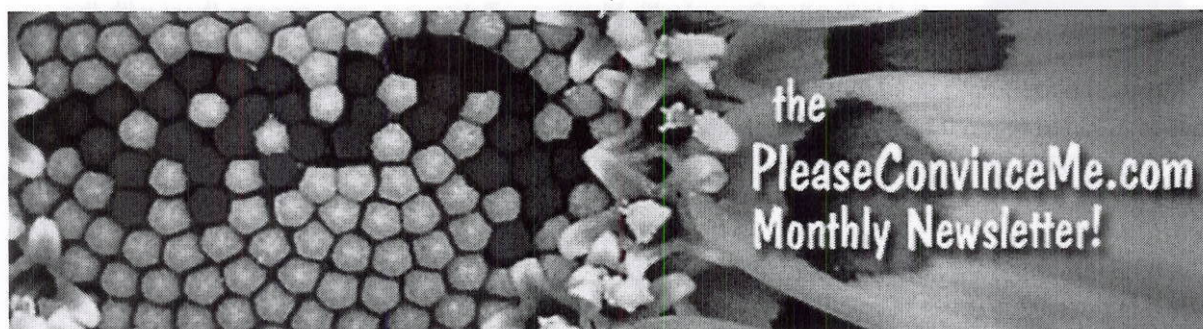

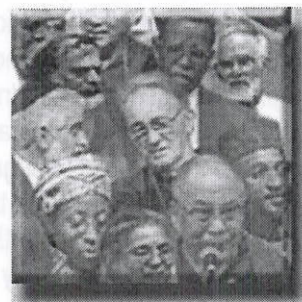
Greetings!

Most of us, as Christians, would agree that we ought to share the joy that we have as believers. Most of us would agree that we are called to share the Gospel and have been commissioned by Jesus to do so. But is there a limit? Are there some people with whom we shouldn't share at all? What about people of different belief systems? What about people who have different THEISTIC views? What about Buddhists? What about Muslims? Most of us would say, "Yes, we ought to share the Gospel with these people who don't know Jesus!"

But what about people who already say they know Jesus? Should we share the Gospel with Jehovah's Witnesses? Should we evangelize Mormons? Don't these people already have the Good News? 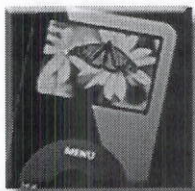

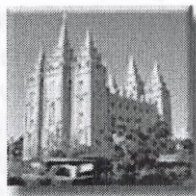

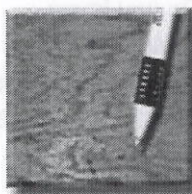
Read About the Trip!
