1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The report is to inform members of the Results for 2008 of teacher assessment at KS3.

2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 Teacher assessment is not moderated externally. Teachers arrive at judgements for each pupil using assessment information gathered during the course of key stage 3. Exemplification material is made available to schools in order to moderate standards internally against the level description contained in the agreed syllabus.
- 2.2 L5+ is the figure for those pupils gaining a level 5 or above in Religious Education L6+ is the figure for those pupils gaining a level 6 or above in Religious Education NL means that no level was able to be awarded to those pupils

3. COMMENTARY ON LEVELS ANALYSIS AT KS3

- 3.1 All schools in the LEA responded.
- 3.2 Results are better in 2008 than 2007 for boys only, girls only and all pupils at Level5+ and L6+.
- 3.3 The gap in performance between boys and girls at L5+ and L6+ has narrowed this year.
