## Standards in RE

## **KS3 Shortcomings:**

- A significant minority of pupils lacks a secure understanding of religious ideas. With some their recollection is uncertain; with others their understanding is superficial.
- A significant minority of pupils shows limited skills of exploring their understanding of religious ideas and responding to new knowledge. Their ability to speak at length giving extended answers is limited.

## **KS4 Shortcomings:**

- A significant minority of pupils shows limited skills of exploring their understanding and responding to new knowledge about religion. Their ability to give extended answers is limited.
- A significant minority of pupils finds difficulty in managing their own learning in religious education. Their ability to judge their own performance and identify targets for improvement is limited.

**Spiritual and moral**: Pupils make good progress in their spiritual, moral, social and cultural development. The comprehensive PSE programme, class-tutor periods and assemblies make a very positive contribution to pupils' moral, social and spiritual development.

**Collective Worship**: The school complies with the statutory requirements of a daily act of collective worship.

**Progress since the last inspection:** The school is now meeting statutory requirements in respect of a daily act of collective worship.

**Recommendation:** Continue to raise standards by addressing the shortcomings in subjects identified in this report.
