SUBJECT: MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To update members on the current membership of Caerphilly SACRE.

2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 There have been two recent retirements from the committee; Sian Puw John (UCAC) and Carolyn Cook (NASUWT).
- 2.2 Two letters have been sent to NASUWT, Cardiff (dated 9th June and 17th August) and one to UCAC, Aberystwyth (dated 17th August), requesting assistance in finding a replacement, but no response has been received to date.
- 2.3 Recent correspondence suggests a significant Buddhist community in the Caerphilly County area, and a new Tibetan Buddhist centre has recently opened in Caerphilly town centre. Brian Pearce, Chairman of the Buddhist Council of Wales has indicated that he will raise the matter of SACRE membership at their next meeting (in September). Following this, he may be able to nominate a candidate for the Committee to consider, should the Committee decide it appropriate to have a Buddhist join the group.
