1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 2.1 For **all** inspections, there is a written report on seven key questions. There are three types of inspection:

- i) For **short** inspections, there are no subject reports;
- ii) For **standard** inspections, there are also reports on six subjects;
- iii) For **full** inspections, there are also reports on all subjects.

- 2.2 The five-point scale used by Estyn is as follows:

- **Grade 1** good with outstanding features
- **Grade 2** good features and no important shortcomings
- **Grade 3** good features outweigh shortcomings
- **Grade 4** some good features, but shortcomings in important areas
- **Grade 5** many important shortcomings
