1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To inform members of Caerphilly SACRE of Estyn's inspection reports.

2. INFORMATION

- 2.1 For **all** inspections, there is a written report on seven key questions. There are three types of inspection:
 - i) For **short** inspections, there are no subject reports;
 - ii) For **standard** inspections, there are also reports on six subjects;
 - iii) For full inspections, there are also reports on all subjects.
- 2.2 The five-point scale used by Estyn is as follows:
 - Grade 1 good with outstanding features
 - Grade 2 good features and no important shortcomings
 - Grade 3 good features outweigh shortcomings
 - Grade 4 some good features, but shortcomings in important areas
 - Grade 5 many important shortcomings
