## APPENDIX 1

## COMMENTARY ON LEVELS ANALYSIS AT KS3

- All schools in the LA responded
- There has been an improvement in results in 2010 over 2009 at L5+ for boys only, girls only and all pupils.
- Results at L6+ have remained unchanged in 2010 for boys only, girls only and all pupils.
- The gap in performance between boys and girls at L5+ had narrowed in 2009 (12\%) but increased to $16 \%$ in 2010. This gender gap in performance is also evident in English and History.
- The gap in performance between boys and girls at L6+ has remained consistent at $10 \%$ over the last three years.
