- 2.1 There are three types of inspection. For all inspections, there is a written report on seven key questions. For short inspections, there are no subject reports. For standards inspections, there are also reports on six subjects. For full inspections, there are also reports on all subjects.
- 2.2 The five-point scale used by Estyn is as follows:

Grade 1 good with outstanding features

Grade 2 good features and no important shortcomings

Grade 3 good features outweigh shortcomings

Grade 4 some good features, but shortcomings in important areas

Grade 5 many important shortcomings.

2.3 From September 2010 the new inspection framework will be introduced to all schools and all inspection reports will be short reports.
