## COMMENTARY ON LEVELS ANALYSIS AT KS3

- All schools in the LA responded.
- Results at L5+ are $68.3 \%$ for all pupils and remains consistent with 2010 (68.4\%). However there has been an improvement in results for boys by approx $4 \%$ but for girls their results decreased by $4 \%$. This means the gap in performance between boys and girls of boys has narrowed with it being 16\% in 2010 and approx 7\% in 2011. The results overall are below English and History for the LA and All Wales figures.
- Results at L6+ in 2011 are 25.9\% and are below 2010 performance (29.2\%). Boys' performance has remained unchanged whilst girls' performance is below 2010 by approx 7\%. The gap in performance between boys and girls has again narrowed at L6+ with it being $10 \%$ in 2010 and approx 3\% in 2011. The results overall are below English and History for the LA and All Wales figures.
- The gap in performance between boys and girls has greatly narrowed in 2011 at both L5+ and L6+. This is better than the gender gap in performance in All Wales English (13\%) and History at L5+ (11\%) and at L6+ (13\%)
