2.2 Humanist Representation on SACREs

2.2.1 WASACRE wrote to the Welsh Government, on behalf of SACREs in Wales, regarding the request of the Humanist Association to Welsh SACREs to be appointed as a member of Committee A. The response from WG was a copy of the 1996 Education Act and its constitution for advisory councils (Appendix 2). There has been no legal change to this constitution since that date.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS

 - (1) that the clerk to SACRE contact the appropriate people or organisations to ensure vacant places are filled; and
