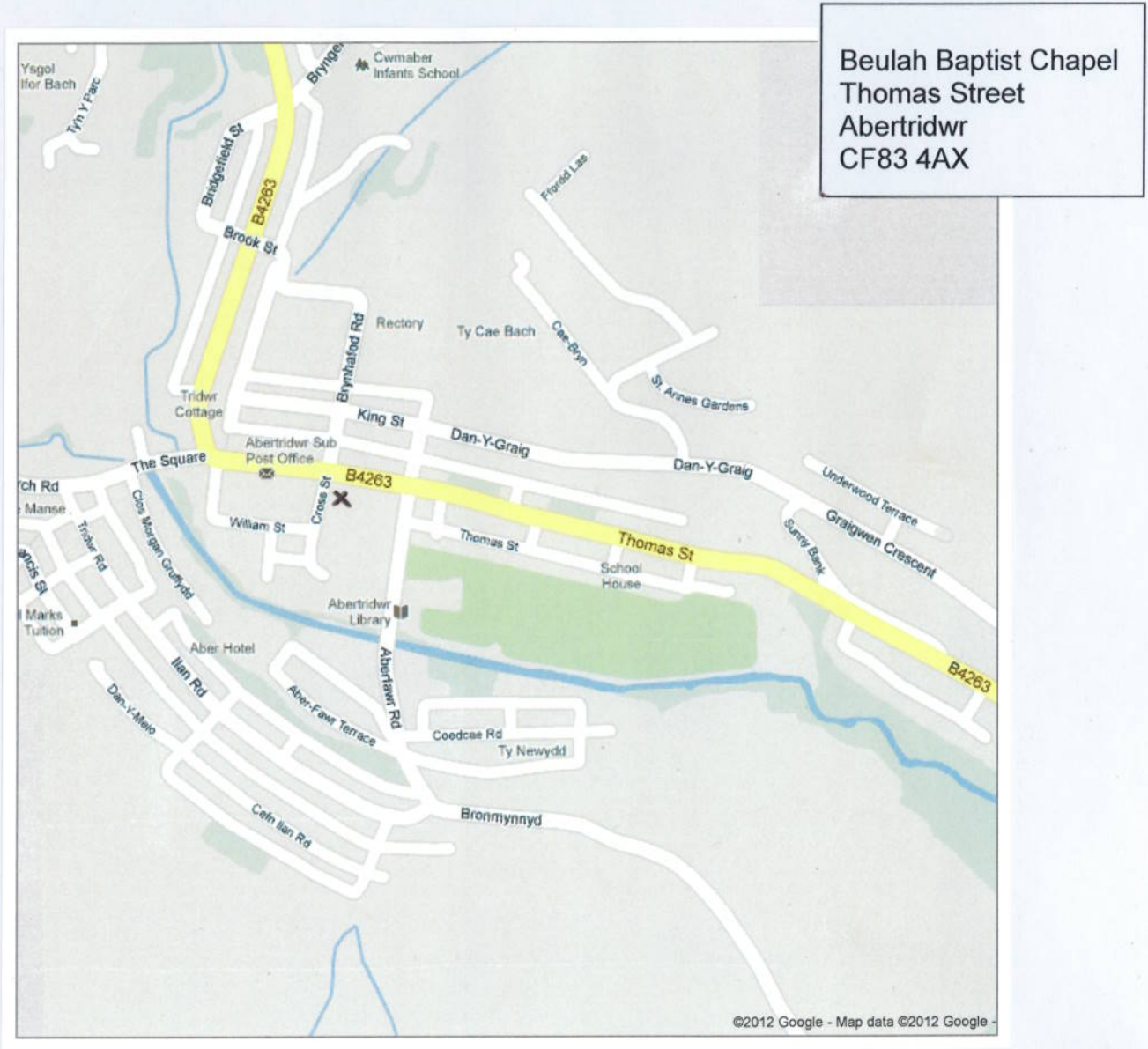

FROM CARDIFF

Head North along the A470

Take the A4054 / A468 exit towards Treforest / Caerphilly

At the roadabout take the 3rd exit onto the Caerphilly Road / A468

Continue to follow this road, passing over one roadabout

When approaching the 2nd roundabout (St Cenydd) get in the left lane

Turn left onto the St. Cenydd Road / B4263

At the first roundabout turn left, continuing along the B4263

The Church is on the left at the cross roads of Cross Street, Thomas Street and Kings Close

Entrance to the Chapel is via Cross Street
