

Request for alteration to a street light in Castle Street, Caerphilly

Many visitors to Caerphilly Castle use the footpath that connects Castle Street and the main (east) entrance to the castle. The path is used during normal opening hours and also when there are evening events held in the Great Hall. As a consequence the path is quite well used during the hours of darkness. It has been suggested that the lighting of the path, in particular the stepped section, could be improved.



With that in mind I wonder if it would be possible for the existing single lighting unit to be replaced with a double unit as shown in the photograph below.



I should be grateful if the Town Centre Management Group would consider recommending this proposal to the appropriate division of the County Borough Council.
