Caerphilly Local History Society have provided some pointers in sourcing photographs of the old entrance feature.

Newport Library

Newport Library have checked through their records for information or illustrations relating to the Eisteddfod in 1950. They could not find anything. They checked the South Wales Argus index, online resources and catalogue cards.

The Glamorgan Record Office have also checked through their records and unfortunately cannot find any relevant material.

It is believed that Reginald Moore Ltd, who are still in existence today, built the feature. After contacting Reginald Moore, they have checked and they do not have any old photographs of the feature.

Caerphilly and Bargoed libraries have been visited to check through their local history books and again there is no evidence of the entrance feature.

Caerphilly library have been contacted in one more attempt for information and they have informed the council that they have no photographs or details that would be of use.

Most recently, on the 9th May, another letter was sent to the Caerphilly Local History Society asking for their help in sourcing a photograph of the entrance feature. I am currently awaiting a response from them.
