**SUBJECT: COMMUNITY CENTRES CONSTITUTION – COMMUNITY COUNCIL REPRESENTATION**

- 1 The new community centres' constitution has now been adopted by the management committees of all centres within the Council's borough wide network (generic copy attached) The terms of that constitution allows for community councils to be represented upon the management committees of centres situated within community wards by no more than one community councillor per centre (as appointed by their respective council). Nominees will serve as 'ex officio' committee members, with voting rights, and may serve on one or more centre committees within their community ward.
2. Community Councillors who may also be County Borough Councillors may only represent one Council on any one centre management committee. Appointments other than the first shall be confirmed at the Annual General Meeting for each centre.
3. The following community centres therefore require appointments from the respective community/town council:-
