1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform members, Management and Trade Union Safety Representatives of enforcement action against this authority, taken recently by the Health and Safety Executive.

2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 Following a visit to a construction site at Newbridge Comprehensive School where the Building Maintenance DLO was undertaking work, two Enforcement Notices were served on the Authority.
- 2.2 A Prohibition Notice was served in respect of a lack of edge protection on tower scaffolding and other elevated workplaces on the site.
- 2.3 Remedial work, to replace guardrails, previously removed to build a ramp, was completed by the following working day, obviating the terms of the Notice.
- 2.4 An Improvement Notice, requiring that site foremen receive further instruction in health and safety site management was also served. The Corporate Safety Unit has, on a number of occasions recommended that foremen receive appropriate training to ensure their competence and has facilitated several courses in the past.
- 2.5 An appropriate Course has been identified and arrangements made for 10 Supervisors and Foremen, who undertake contract work to receive instruction during July. Consideration is being given to a further, similar Course in the future.
- 2.6 In addition, a Course designed to equip Foremen and Supervisors to inspect scaffolding is being arranged.
