SUBJECT: TRANSPORT ISSUES AT TIR-Y-BERTH

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform Members, Management and Trade Union Safety Representatives of progress in improving pedestrian and vehicular safety at Tir-y-berth Depot.

2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 For the information of new members to this committee, some months ago, concern was expressed about the safety of pedestrians and vehicles using the Tir-y-Berth Depot.
- 2.2 Following discussion with the Chair of the Tir-y-Berth Depot Management Group a traffic management plan was drawn up by the Corporate Safety Unit and, on instruction from the Corporate Management Team, tenders were sought from Traffic Management Consultants to audit the Corporate Safety Unit's proposals.
- 2.3 In early June, a consultant from North Cheshire Training visited the site to investigate the current position and make recommendations for improvement.
- 2.4 The report, makes a small number of improvements on the Corporate Safety Unit's proposals.
- 2.5 The report and its recommendations have now been passed to the Chairman of the Tir-y-Berth Depot Management Group for implementation as soon as possible.
- 2.6 It is understood that funds will be identified for any improvements found to be necessary.

3. RECOMMENDATION

3.1 That the contents of the report be noted.
