SUBJECT: HEALTH AND SAFETY TRAINING

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform Members, Management and Trade Union Safety Representatives of a series of health and safety courses, attended by Managers, Supervisors and health and safety personnel.

2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 As part of the Council's Management and Development Policy, 51 Managers, Supervisors and "hands on" health and safety staff attended I.O.S.H. Health and Safety Certificate Courses during March and April.
- 2.2 Attendees, drawn from each Directorate, received 4 days instruction in health and safety topics.
- 2.3 In order to qualify for the certificate, delegates sat a written examination and submitted an assessment.
- 2.4 With the exception of 3 officers, who failed to comply with the latter requirement, every attendee was successful.
