## 1. **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform Members, Management and Trade Union Safety Representatives of a planned HSE Inspection of Refuse and Recycling.

## 2. **SUMMARY**

- 2.1 The HSE has indicated that they will be inspecting 50% of Local Authorities in Wales as part of a planned inspection programme.
- Caerphilly County Borough Council will be visited with the planned inspection taking place between November 9<sup>th</sup> and Christmas. 2.2
- The inspection will be based on the HSE's priority programme and will focus on: -2.3
  - Working at heights
  - Musculoskeletal disorders
  - Stress
  - Workplace transport
  - Slips and trips
- 2.4 The relevant Managers have been briefed and the Directorate of the Environment Safety Officers are working with Managers to ensure they are fully prepared for the inspection.
