SUBJECT: RECENT HSE UPDATES

## 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform Members, Management and Trade Union Safety Representatives of recent updates in Health and Safety information, advice and guidance.

## 2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 The HSE have decided to harmonise commencement dates for new health and safety legislation. From 2005, domestic legislation will be implemented on two days each year: 6 April and 1 October. This will not apply to legislation arising from EU Directives, however where possible the HSE will align such legislation with common commencement dates.
- 2.2 Working at Height Legislation new draft Working at Height Regulations are currently with the Minster and are expected to come into force in April. The HSE has decided to remove the 2metre rule meaning a risk assessment needs to be carried out prior to deciding on precautions for all working at height and no specific prescriptive requirements will be applicable to work at 2 metres or above.
