
Hazardous Substance Warning Labels

Examples of labelling changes



New labels to be introduced from 1st October 2008

Warning: harmful if inhaled;

Warning: causes skin

irritation

Warning: Causes serious

eve irritation



Danger: may cause allergy or asthma symptoms or breathing difficulties if

inhaled;

Danger: may cause cancer; Danger: may damage fertility or

the unborn child;

Danger: may cause damage to

organs;

Warning: May cause respiratory irritation / narcotic effects / drowsiness and dizziness; Danger: may be fatal/harmful if

swallowed and enters

airways.
