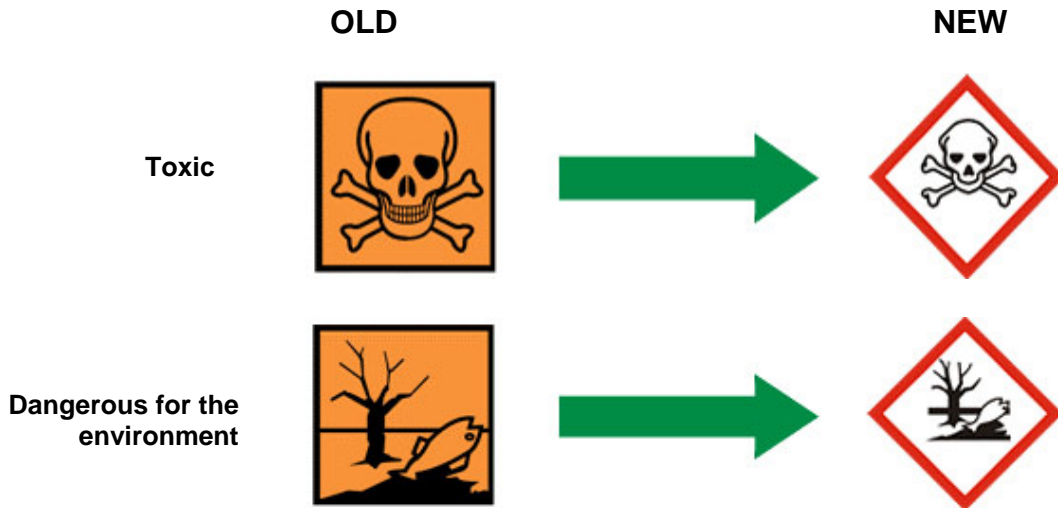


## Hazardous Substance Warning Labels

### Examples of labelling changes



### New labels to be introduced from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2008

Warning: harmful if inhaled;  
 Warning: causes skin irritation  
 Warning: Causes serious eye irritation



Danger: may cause allergy or asthma symptoms or breathing difficulties if inhaled;

Danger: may cause cancer;  
 Danger: may damage fertility or the unborn child;  
 Danger: may cause damage to organs;

Warning: May cause respiratory irritation / narcotic effects / drowsiness and dizziness;

Danger: may be fatal/harmful if swallowed and enters airways.
