1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To inform Members of the purchase of a Committee Management Software system and actions taken to date for its implementation.

2.1 The software system will automate significant part of the committee services processes and provide further reassurance that the Council complies with its statutory duty to ensure committee documents are published within 3 clear days. In addition, the software will ensure electronic copies of committee documents are kept in a secure environment which is publically accessible.

- 3.1 Following a tender exercise the Council awarded a contract to Modernmindset for the supply and maintenance of 'Modern.gov', a committee management software system.
- 3.2 Attached at appendix 1 is a highlight report outlining the actions taken to date in implementing the software system.
- 3.3 Once the implementation of the software is completed the system will be demonstrated to the committee.
