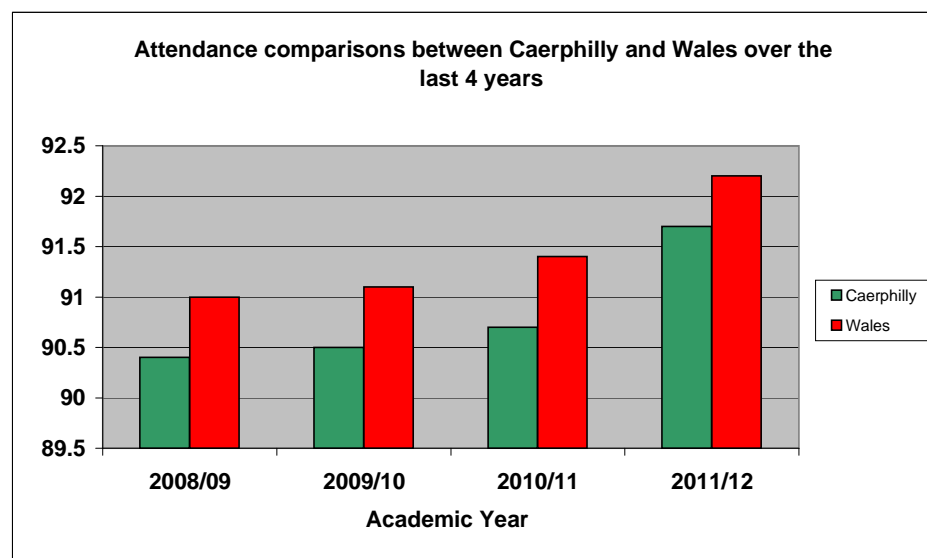


Secondary Attendance comparisons between Caerphilly Local Authority and Wales to Academic year 2011/2012

There has been consistent improvement in Secondary School attendance over the past 4 years. Validated data record a 1% increase in attendance for 2011/12 compared to the 2010/11 figures. The data records CCBC being 0.5% behind the All Wales figure of 92.2%, but improving at a higher rate than the Welsh average; the All Wales improvement for 2011/12 being 0.8%. 14 schools (100%) matched or exceeded their attendance from the previous academic year. 10 schools (71%) matched or exceeded the LA Target of 91.7%. The 2011/12 figures record an improvement of 0.3% in unauthorised absence rates from the 2010/11 figures, which was 0.4% better than the All Wales average which confirms that CCBC have improved at a faster rate than the All Wales average, which is reported as being 0.1%. The data records Caerphilly as being ranked joint 18th with Cardiff.
