Foster Carer Retainer Payments

- Caerphilly County Borough Council values its Foster Carers and strives to ensure that Foster Carers are recruited and retained to meet the needs of the Looked After Children population.
- 2. It is acknowledged that on occasions approved Foster Carers will not have a child or young person in placement. In order to retain Foster Carers it will be necessary to pay a retainer.
- 3. A retainer payment of £110 per week will be paid to Career Foster Carers and a payment of £55 per week will be paid to Probationary and Mainstream Foster Carers when there is no child in placement. The retainer payment will be paid for a maximum period of three months unless one of the circumstances detailed below applies:

Circumstances where retainer payments will not be paid, may cease or be reviewed:

- 1. In order to qualify for the retainer payment, the Foster Carer must have had at least one full time placement. Newly approved Foster Carers will not receive a retainer payment until they have provided at least one full time placement.
- 2. Foster Carers will not be paid a retainer payment if they have expressed a wish to be placed on hold i.e. they do not wish to be considered for placements for a period of time for reasons agreed with the Fostering Team.
- 3. Foster Carers will not be paid a retainer payment if they take holidays in excess of their two weeks paid annual leave entitlement.
- 4. The retainer payment will be reviewed by the Team Manager and/or Service Manager on a monthly basis and a decision made as to whether or not the retainer payment should continue in the following circumstances:
 - Where there have been concerns or allegations made against Foster Carers and children have been removed whilst an investigation is pending
 - Where carers have refused to take children / young people who are considered by the Fostering Team to be an appropriate and suitable match.

NB: Respite placements are not considered to be full time placements for the purposes of this policy.
