1. Foreword

Caerphilly County Borough Council is committed to achieving value for money from its annual Procurement expenditure, which can be influenced; this area is in the region of £180m.

This Procurement Strategy sets out how we intend to deliver this through effective and more strategic procurement and collaborative working.

The strategy underpins and supports the delivery of the Council's Corporate Plan. The Council's vision is "Working together for the good of all".

Procurement has a key role to play in helping the Council achieve it's visions, by ensuring that value and efficiency is delivered from every provider and that we use our resource to develop and nurture regeneration within our local communities.

2. Introduction

What is Procurement?

Procurement is the acquisition of goods, works and services.

Procurement takes into consideration the whole process of acquisition from third parties, covering goods, services, revenue projects and capital works. The process spans the whole-life cycle from initial concept through to the end of the useful life of the asset (including disposal) or the end of a service contract. Both conventionally funded and more innovative approaches such as PPP/PFI are included.

Procurement has a much broader meaning than Purchasing. Good effective procurement will enable the authority to secure, goods, works and services that best meet the needs of end users and the local community whilst delivering the Council's key aims and objectives.

Procurement is about making a choice, and the choice we make in relation to the way the authority spend its budgets will impact upon and affect generations to come, if we get it wrong, the consequences could be severe. One thing is for sure the way in which we make choices today will shape and position the authority on how it wishes to be viewed and accepted.

Procurement is organised within the authority as a devolved activity supported by a Strategic lead network of procurement professionals. <u>(See structure Procurement</u>) <u>Website www.caerphilly.gov.uk/procurement</u>)

Achievements to date

The 2004-2008 procurement strategy was the first procurement strategy for the authority. It set out clear areas for improvement, which were supported by a detailed action plan, as a result of a Procurement Best Value Service review.

95% in the action plan is complete; these have all been fully endorsed by the Corporate Procurement Group.

There is now a clear sense of awareness within the authority of the effectiveness of procurement. This awareness is clear amongst leading Politician's (cross party) and Chief Officers. The goal this time is to embed the principles of effective procurement within the everyday culture of all officers of the authority. One of the most noticeable

achievements in the last 3 years is the development of SME (small and medium sized enterprises). Caerphilly is a leader in the field of supply chain development within the SME environment. The Authority is committed to the Welsh Assembly's SME charter "opening doors" at Cabinet level, and is one of the few public sector organisations to do so at this level. SME development has become an integral part of the procurement activity and one that the authority should be very proud of.

Over the last 3 years, the Corporate Procurement Team has excelled in its Academic achievements. Skills development and academic success has become a key feature of individual training plans. This approach must now be developed across the authority. The success of the last strategy is borne out by the increased involvement of the procurement professional on key strategic projects in 2005. Prior to 2004, the procurement professional impact was less than 10% of the corporate spend. Today the procurement professional impacts in excess of 50% of the Corporate spend. This is still short of our targets but moving in the right direction, and improved collaboration with other professionals throughout the authority will help to achieve the aims and objectives set.

Comments from Cabinet Member, Cllr Colin Mann - Cabinet Member for Finance and Sustainability

This is the second procurement strategy, which has been developed by the organisation within the last five years.

The authority currently spends in the region of £180m each year on external goods, works and services via third party providers. Caerphilly is a complex organisation, which delivers a diverse range of services to the citizens of Caerphilly County Borough Council. We have a complex structure of contracts, which bring risk and market complexities. Therefore it is vital that we build a framework of professional capacity to organise procurement in the best possible way. Maximizing on collaboration opportunities, development of the supply chain and delivering best value.

This strategy will provide the basis for us to develop and grow the procurement activity within the authority, which will assist us in delivering better public services through a procurement activity that is customer focused, and is an integral part of the authority's business.

The Cabinet is fully supportive of effective, compliant procurement and as Cabinet Member for Procurement I would like to reaffirm my support and commitment to fulfilling the objective set out within this document.

3. The aim of the Strategy

The aim of our Procurement Strategy is to

"Obtain value for money through Planned, Professionally Managed and Sustainable Procurement "

The purpose of the Corporate Procurement Unit is to deliver Supply Chain Management that will assist customers to develop better public services for the County Borough of Caerphilly by considering whole life costs together with sustainability and equality requirements and by maximising the use of a mixed economy of suppliers.

4. Scope of the Strategy

This strategy covers the next four years and is intended to:

- Set out the principles and framework for the Council's (and where relevant its partners) approach to Procurement.
- Give guidance and direction to Officers and Members in fulfilling their objectives to Best Value Procurement.

5. Key Objectives of The Strategy.

- To provide a clear implementation plan of how the objectives of the strategy will be achieved. The plan will be reviewed annually by the Corporate Procurement Group and therefore will remain a working document. Progress on the Strategy will be reported annually to P & R Scrutiny.
- Support the Councils vision and goals.
- Contribute to the identification and delivery of Procurement related savings of approximately 5% in 08/09 and 09/10.
- Support the statutory duty to achieve Best Value.
- To embed Strategic Procurement into all elements of the business, negate commercial risk and effectively manage and develop the Supply Chain.
- Promote the development of organisational capacity and capability to deliver successful procurement, commissioning and contract management.

6. Governance Structure

The Governance Structure for our approach to Procurement is:

- Leadership through the Cabinet Member for Finance and Sustainability
- CMT Leadership through the Director of Corporate Services
- A Corporate Procurement Unit lead by the Head of Procurement. The team consists of 26 members of staff. The Corporate Procurement unit is responsible for the development of corporate procurement policies and procedures, promoting efficiency gains, identifying and consolidation, best practise, setting standards, identifying and facilitating collaborative opportunities, SME Development, development and implementation of e-Procurement. The Corporate Procurement Unit also provides advice, guidance and lead procurement support to all service areas.
- Corporate Procurement Group chaired by Director of Corporate Services with Senior Officer Membership from each Directorate and Cabinet Member.

7. Corporate Procurement Team will:

Provide Corporate Procurement Policies and Procedures;
 Instigate the aggregation of goods and services in communities across the County, undertake the procurement process, develop agreements and centrally manage procurement contracts, which have all authority benefits and those of a collaborative nature arranged by other public sector organisations.

- Provide a range of services, from advice to undertaking the full procurement process for individual departments in specific procurement projects.
- Be involved and consulted in services delivery option reviews.
- Liaise with consortia and other public sector organisations on collaborative and other procurement related topics.
- Maintain a register of agreements with suppliers, identify areas of spend and strategy for future tendering processes.
- Develop and promote appropriate Contract Strategies relevant to the goods, services or works required.
- In association with the Head of Legal Services and his team, develop document templates for use in the tendering / contracting process.
- Contribute to the overall efficiency saving for the authority of 5%.

8. Objectives of the Procurement Management Team

- The Corporate Procurement Team will facilitate a change management process regarding procurement and commissioning issues so that the authority can meet the challenges presented to it on a national, regional and local basis.
- Provide a clear framework for procurement priorities throughout the Council; which Ensures that all procurement decisions are made on a consistent and transparent basis, with a clear legal framework.
- Ensure the Council delivers against its statutory requirements including EU Procurement.
- Identifying core authority wide Procurement Key Performance Indicators. Measure internally and externally using the internal PIMS System and Benchmarking via CIPFA Benchmarking club.
- Ensure the authority meets its obligations in relation to sustainable procurement, and equalities legislation.
- Continue to effectively engage with SME's, Social Enterprises, Ethnic Minority businesses and voluntary sector organisations. Ensure the authority continues with the principles set out in the Welsh Assembly Government Policy Document "Opening Doors"

9. Procurement Principles – Action Plan

9a. Supplier relationships

The authority is complex in its structure and working practices however this document will reaffirm the commitment of the authority in working with a diverse range of suppliers. The authority will be active in developing the supply chain in critical areas of supply, with a mixed economy of suppliers. The Authority acknowledges the benefits of local provision however, the procurement process will be developed in terms of not relying on too small a number of suppliers for strategically critical commodities and ensuring that providers with the majority of their annual turnover with the authority, will not put the service of the authority at any increased risk.
