2. APPLICATIONS FOR THE RELEASE OF PENSION BENEFITS UNDER THE REGULATION 31 (85 YEAR RULE)

Members considered the seven public interest test certificates from the Proper Officer and concluded that on balance the public interests in maintaining the exemption outweighed the public interest in disclosing the information and it was:-

RESOLVED that in accordance with Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 the public be excluded from the remainder of the meeting because of the likely disclosure to them of exempt information as identified in paragraphs 12 and 14 of Part 4 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972. Consideration was given to the reports which detailed various applications for early access to pension benefits under Regulation 31 (85 year rule). It was noted that the applicants qualifies to apply for early release given their age and continuous service.
