

LAND DRAINAGE REMEDIAL WORKS AT BROOK COTTAGES, CWMFELINFACH

These works were approved by WAG to address the damage that sustained by the previous work in the area carried out in 2007. Part of those works were the installation of two vegetation posts located in the watercourse.

During September 2008, the area was subjected to very high and prolonged rainfall, which completely obliterated the installations by washing down several hundred tonnes of material upstream of the posts.



Blockstone bank protection

These remedial works included blockstone bank protection to stabilise areas that were washed away and improved vegetation posts. The extra costs incurred were a result of further bank erosion since the time of tender.

The works were funded by WAG and the lowest, most successful tender was awarded to Jim Davies Civil Engineering Ltd in the sum of £33,246.10 in July 2009. The result of the extra costs realised a final out-turn figure of £42,634.35.
