Main Proposals



FOUR THEMES

- Supporting culture change;
- Active stewardship;
- Improving collaboration; and
- Improving local delivery



Culture Change

- Establish a national planning advisory and improvement service hosted by Welsh Government
- Develop a competency framework for planners and councillors to ensure that planning becomes a positive enabling activity



Active Stewardship

- Statutory requirement for WG to prepare a National Development Framework;
- A new development management hierarchy
 - Developments of National Significance(submitted to & determined by Welsh Ministers),
 - Major Developments,
 - Local Developments and
 - Permitted Developments.



Improve collaboration



- Establish a system of Strategic Development Plans to address larger than local issues.
- Enable Ministers to direct LPAs to prepare a joint LDP.
- Provide an updated legal framework to enable LPAs to be merged.



Improve Delivery

- Common performance framework good local planning service;
- Improve LDP process;
- Produce an annual report on service delivery;
- Improvements to improve efficiency and local delivery.



Development Management

- Front loading processes to provide effective preapplication advice;
- Clarifying statutory consultees' contribution at different stages;
- Improvements to the operation and effectiveness of planning committee.



Local Development Plan

- LDP system remains essential tool;
- Lesson learnt from LDP Refinement;
- Joint LDPs proposed direction power for Welsh Ministers;
- Prior notification requirement LDP withdrawal;
- End date of LDPs
