1. APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence had been received from Councillor C. J. Cuss and Mr S. Harris (Acting Head of Corporate Finance).

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

3. MINUTES

The Panel received and approved the minutes of the Grants to the Voluntary Sector Panel held on 11th July 2013 (minute nos. 1-7; page nos. 1-3).

4. APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

4.1 Statement of Expenditure

The Panel noted the statement of expenditure set out in the report and the balance remaining.

In terms of the report requested at a previous meeting of the Panel, Members were informed that the Council's policy relating to applications from organisations for discretionary rate relief was being looked at as part of the Medium Term Financial Plan.

Reference was made to other grants that are available to organisations and individuals and to the possibility of there being duplication in some areas. It was agreed that officers would seek further information on this matter and report back to the next meeting.

4.2 Welsh Church Act Fund

Members noted the Welsh Church Act Fund applications received and approved by officers since the last meeting in accordance with the agreed criteria as set out in Appendix 3. The total allocated amounts to £22,945.20. Monmouthshire County Council have confirmed that underspends from previous years can be carried forward resulting in a total available budget for 2013/14 of £166,291.00.

The amount approved and reported to the last meeting of the panel was £6,000. To date none of the approved grants have been claimed. Successful applicants have a period of 18 months from approval to spend and claim the grant. Some organisations have now exceeded this timescale and as a result letters will be sent to these organisations advising them the grant has been withdrawn. A full list will be available at the next meeting.

Members noted the information and acknowledged the need to promote the fund and encourage more applications.

4.3 Applications for Financial Assistance: Panel Awards

Members were asked to consider the applications listed in Appendix 1 to the report and to make appropriate recommendations to the Acting Head of Corporate Finance for approval.
