SUBJECT: DIVERSION OF FOOTPATH NO. 41 IN THE COMMUNITY OF

MYNYDDISLWYN

REPORT BY: DIRECTOR OF THE ENVIRONMENT

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To advise Members of a diversion in respect of footpath No.41 in the Community of Mynyddislwyn

2. SUMMARY

2.1 To consider an application by the Chief Property Officer on behalf of the Director of Education for the diversion of footpath No.41 in the Community of Mynyddislwyn

4. THE REPORT

- 4.1 Footpath No.41 in the Community of Mynyddislwyn is a registered right of way and recorded on the definitive map and statement relevant date 1st July 1952 prepared by Monmouthshire County Council under the terms of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949.
- 4.2 For identification purposes the line of the path is indicated on the Location Plan/ Definitive Map attached as Document No.1
- 4.3 The path is described in the definitive statement as:

Footpath 41 Mynyddislwyn Islwyn Terrace 1879 OS

Branches from 40 across Waen N.W. to Maesygarn Farm through farmyard and via lane to North of Islwyn Terrace

- 4.4 An application has been received from the Chief Property Officer on behalf of the Director of Education seeking the diversion of the route of footpath No.41 Mynyddislwyn as a result of a planning permission being granted on the 6th October 2005 No.P/050972 for the new Oakdale Infants School.
- 4.5 Following receipt of the application the Authority has undertaken a pre order consultation exercise with interested parties. Replies have been received from the Local Members, Welsh Water, and BT. Of those replies received no objections have been raised to the proposals.

Mr. K. Donovan representing the Ramblers Association has verbally expressed his support for the diversion.

- The applicants have agreed to the following matters which are required by highway authority: 4.6
 - 1. the cost of the order procedure estimated to be in the region of £1,800.00 to be borne by the applicant
 - 2. Anti motor cycling barriers to be erected at either end of path to prevent misuse
 - 3. the alternative route to be constructed to a minimum width of 1.8 metres and a minimum of blinded hardcore surface to a gradient not exceeding 1 in 8. If gradient is exceeded then a ramped step to be considered and agreed prior to construction
- 4.7 Document No.2 is a detailed plan indicating the definitive line of footpath No.41 Mynyddislwyn by a solid bold black line between points A-B. The proposed alternative path is also indicated on Document No.2 by a dashed bold black line between points B-C-D-A.

8. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

8.1 That a diversion order be processed under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 in accordance with the following descriptions;

Description of Existing Path or Way

That part of footpath No.41 Mynyddislwyn commencing at a point approximately 17 metres north of the centre of the property known as 22 Pen-Y-Fan Way and proceeding in a north westerly direction to its termination on B4251 Oakdale to Croes-pen-maen road at a point approximately 96 metres north north west of the said property a total distance of 83 metres or thereabouts and shown on plan by a bold black line between points B-A

Description of Alternative Path or Way

A new path to a width of 1.8 metres commencing at a point approximately 17 metres north of the centre of the property known as 22 Pen-Y-Fan Way and proceeding in a south westerly, curving to a north north westerly direction then continuing in an east north easterly direction to its termination on B4251 Oakdale to Croes-pen-maen road at a point approximately 96 metres north north west of the said property a total distance of 193 metres or thereabouts and shown on plan by a bold black dashed line between points B-C-D-A.
