Thank you for your letter advising of road safety concerns with a proposed bridleway near your home, with the access and egress being on Twyn Gwyn Road.

I have visited the area and would agree for any drivers using this single lane width road, driving towards Cwmfelinfach the proposed entry point onto Twyn Gwyn Road would be concealed for these drivers due to the topography of the road and could result in collisions or incidents with any horses and riders making use of the facility.

As you can appreciate this is a matter for the local authority to ensure that any works which involve the use of the highway is risk assessed, to ensure road safety is fully considered. It may be appropriate to ensure the visibility is improved and the access is well signed or to seek a more appropriate access point.

I will forward a copy of your concerns and my response to Caerphilly County Borough Council to ensure that this procedure has been considered.

SGT Steve Parsons' advice was to write to your goodself, and maybe a site visit would be possible to discuss the matter further.

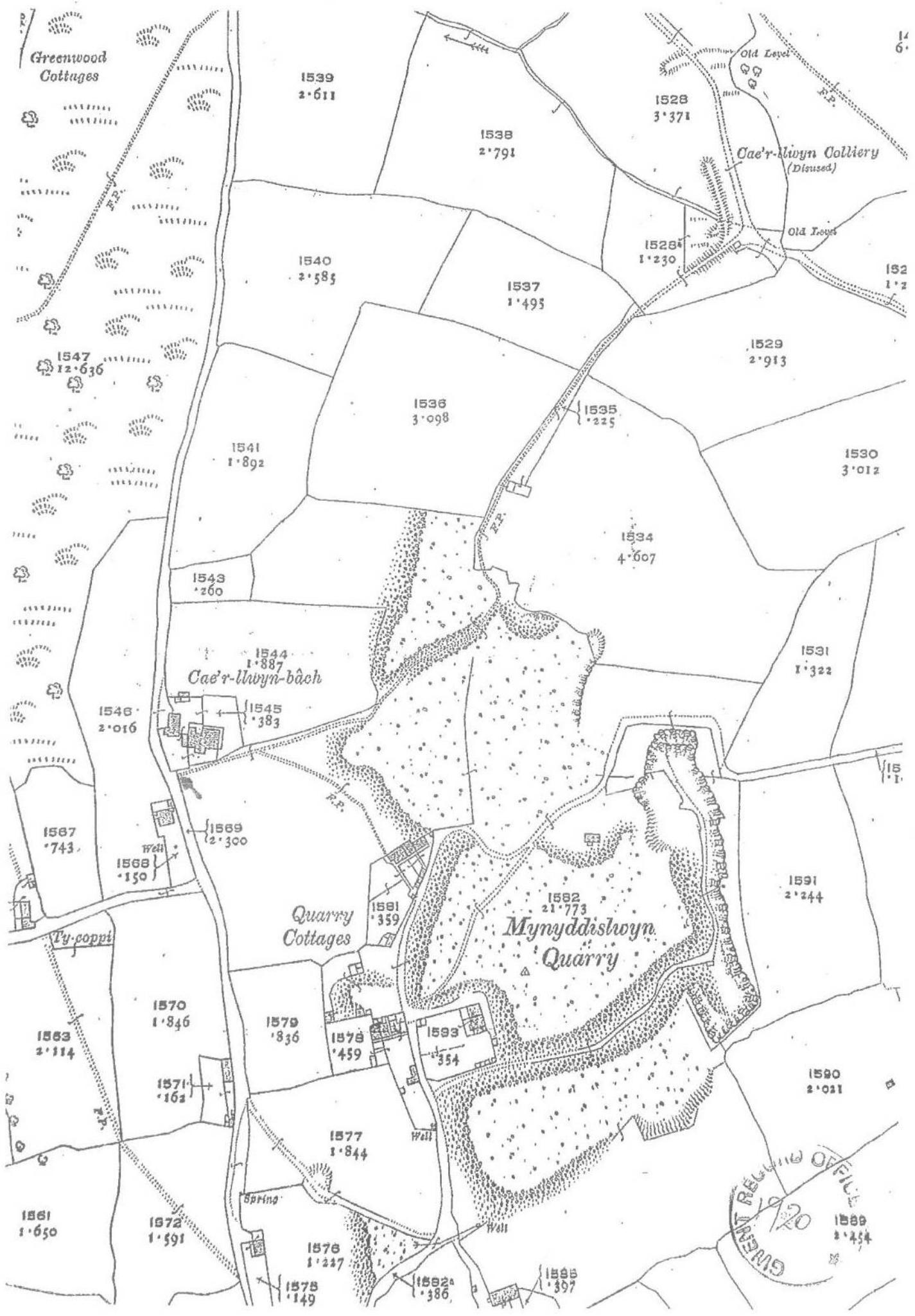
