Re: Deletion of Bridleway No. 152 in the Community of Mynyddislwyn.

With reference to your letter dated 19th November, 2003 I write to confirm that the bridleway No.152 was used by myself and my sister in the late 1960's. We used to ride our horses up through to the top road.

I also write on behalf of my brother Mr Ronald Davies who was born at Ty-Coppi Farm in 1939. He can confirm that during the 1950's he used to use the bridle No. 152 with a horse and cart. He also told me that the only farrier lived in Abercarn and it was a regular thing to use all the bridle ways to get there. His current address is Panty-y-fynnon Farm, Twyn Gwyn Road, Ynysddu.

I would like to add that it is currently impossible to use bridle way No. 152 because during the foot & mouth problem in 2000 the gate at the bottom by Twyn Gwyn Road was removed.

Finally I would like to add that all my family ride horses and do so on a regular basis and feel that all bridle paths not just foot paths should be clearly marked.

Re Bridleway 152 Mynyddislwyn

With refence to the about bridleway.I Write to confirm that i used the bridleway in 1969 I was 10 years old.My sister olwen of Ty-coppi farm also used this bridleway with me. We could not go through Caerllwyn Quarrys during the 60,s because this was closed due to Johnson+ Johnsons tipping waste.My sister and i would ride past Caerllwyn bach farm which would be on the left hand side we would then proceed up through the field to the old quarry bear left around quarry with the rocks on the right hands side a little futher on pass on through a gate leading into a open field with a wall on the left hand side.we would galloped through this field}We would exite the bridleway passing through callwyn mawr farm on to the road. We can still gain asse to the bridleway from Callwyn Mawr farm but since 2000.a gate at Carellwyn Bach Farm was remover we can no longer exite at this point.
