SUBJECT: MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT TRAINING

REPORT BY: MONITORING OFFICER

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To update the Committee on the progress made on the Members Code of Conduct Training.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Details of the training so far undertaken were reported at the Committee's last meeting when concern was expressed that there still remained a number of County Borough Councillors, Community/Town Councillors and Co-opted Members who had not taken the opportunity to attend the 5 sessions that had been arranged. Details of those who had attended were reported and it was agreed that a further session should be arranged and that all those who had not already attended should be encouraged to do so.
- 2.2 The session was held on the evening of 10th December 2008 when a further seven County Borough Councillors and four Community Councillors were present. Another person was present (unidentifiable signature).
- 2.3 The total number of County Borough Councillors who have attended is 60 out of 73. Details of the Community/Town Council attendees and that of Co-opted Members will be reported at the meeting.
- 2.4 Officers have done their utmost to encourage attendance at these sessions and the Committee's views are now requested.
