1. RE: WILLIAMS REPORT ON WELSH LOCAL GOVERNMENT REORGANISATION

- 1.1 On reading the extensive report into the reorganisation of local government in Wales, it was found that of the many paragraphs, only one briefly referred to town and community councils. The report suggests the amalgamation of various borough councils but made no conclusion as to what would happen with town and community councils.
- 1.2 The proposed plan for borough councils would need legislation which would take place after the next Welsh Government elections and it would be at a later date than this that any changes would be made to town and community councils. So in conclusion we in town and community councils cannot expect any changes to our boundaries for many years yet.
