CABINET MEMBER ACTIVITY

As Cabinet Member for Social Services, I act as the Cabinet expert in these areas, ensure that the views and needs of the service are built into the Council's policy framework and the decision making process. I attended 6 Scrutiny meetings where I regularly updated other Members about my key portfolio activities.

During 2014/15, the Council identified Safeguarding Children as one of its Improvement Objectives. In doing so we are committed to ensuring children and young people who are looked after by Caerphilly County Borough Council are supported to achieve their full potential. I attended the opening of a new facility for single homeless people at Ty Croeso, Newbridge. I attended the Celebration of Achievement Awards in partnership with Blaenau Gwent. This was a wonderful opportunity to recognise the achievements of staff at all levels and to publicly thank them for their hard work and commitment. I also had the pleasure of starting the "Walk a Mile in her Shoes" walk around Caerphilly Castle, drawing attention to the White Ribbon Campaign against domestic violence towards women.

Carers from the South East Wales Adult Placement Scheme managed by Caerphilly CBC won a National Gold Award at the Care Forum Wales Awards.

During February 2015 I attended events to celebrate the achievements of almost 100 of the Authority's looked after children. I updated Scrutiny Committee on the national and local reports with regard to safeguarding and care planning of looked after children and care leavers who exhibit vulnerable or risky behaviours.

CONSTITUENCY ACTIVITY

I do not hold surgeries my constituents prefer to contact me in person and by telephone and email.

As Cabinet Member for Social Services and Child Poverty Champion I am extremely busy with my portfolio responsibilities and attend meetings with Health Boards, Welsh Government, Children and Young People Partnership and the Health Social Care and Wellbeing Partnership.
