CABINET MEMBER ACTIVITY

I was elected to the position of Cabinet Member for Community and Leisure Services at the Annual Meeting of Council in May 2015. I regularly updated other Members about my key portfolio activities and as part of that portfolio I attended numerous events and made visits to local business throughout the County Borough.

These included visiting local playing fields, playgrounds and leisure centres, the Sport Caerphilly Legacy Games, Young Ambassador Celebration Day, the Standing Conference and WLGA Annual Conference. I took part in the Affordable Housing Road Trip, the Positive Futures Football Festival Launch and met with the Minister for Natural Resources on the Environment and Sustainable Development Revenue Grant. I was proud to attend the Pride

in Your Place Awards 2015 and the Annual Youth Forum Conference 2015. I was involved in the Budget Consultation Drop-in Sessions that took place throughout the County Borough and was part of the LDP Focus Group. I hold regular monthly meetings with Officers, Senior Managers and Directors to ensure that my portfolio priorities are on track.
